



## ITINERARY TRAVELER WEEKLY PLAN MEXICO CITY

### Monday

- Pick up at Mexico City International Airport at the time of your flight arrival.
- A time to know La Casita and your accommodation and if you wish so, you can tour Coyoacan with a Map we will give to you and a recommendation of restaurants to have dinner.

### Tuesday

- Mexican and International Breakfast at 7:30 a.m. in the Dining Room.
- Departure at 9:00 a.m. with the host guide to Mexico City's Downtown Area.
- At Mexico City's Downtown Area you will visit the Centro Histórico which has several important spots such as:
  - Zócalo (Mexico City's Central and Main Square)
  - Palacio Nacional (National Palace)
  - La Catedral Metropolitana (The Metropolitan Cathedral)
  - Templo Mayor (The Main Aztec Temple)
  - Palacio de Bellas Artes (The Fine Arts Palace)
- After visiting this important spots, you will be headed to the National Anthropology Museum via Reforma (one of the most beautiful avenues in the world). At this place you will be having lunch in an International Buffet – Restaurant (this meal is included, drinks are not included). After the meal you will visit the main rooms of the museum.
- The arrival to La Casita would be between 18:00 and 18:30 p.m.
- Dinner is optional and we recommend for the day "El Lago" Restaurant [www.lago.com.mx](http://www.lago.com.mx), one of the most beautiful restaurants in the city with a

very nice view to the Chapultepec Lake. The restaurant has International Cuisine and the pick up would be at the hour of your preference.

### **Wednesday**

- Mexican and International Breakfast at 8:00 a.m. in the Dining Room.
- Departure at 9:30 a.m. with the host guide towards the Dolores Olmedo Museum. A magnificent hacienda – mansion with the largest collection of Diego Rivera and Frida Kahlo's paintings.
- After visiting Dolores Olmedo Museum you will be headed to Xochimilco for a meal in a trajinera (typical boat) and a tour through the channels (the meal is included).
- After visiting Xochimilco there is a panoramic view to the UNAM (National University) and one of the biggest in the world. After this panoramic view La Casita is waiting for you to rest and get dressed to go to one of our most spectacular attractions in the Plan.
- The spectacular attraction is the Folkloric Ballet of Amalia Hernández that is presented in Palacio de Bellas Artes. But before that you are going to have dinner in a restaurant we will recommend you near the Palace. The Ballet starts at 20:30 p.m.
- The time of arrival at La Casita after the Ballet is at 23:00 p.m.

### **Thursday**

- Mexican and International Breakfast at 7:00 a.m. in the Dining Room.
- Departure at 8:30 a.m. with the host guide towards a panoramic view to Tlatozolco Square, which is a place that embraces very special prehispanic ruins. After this magnificent square you will be headed to the Basilica de Guadalupe which is the top spot of Mexican catholic culture.
- After the Basilica, Teotihuacán is waiting for you with its splendorous pyramids and ancient prehispanic city. This place is the prehispanic center most visited by tourists in Mexico. A very nice restaurant with a nice garden is waiting for you to have lunch at Teotihuacán, this place is "Villas Arqueológicas" (the meal is not included).
- The arrival time at La Casita is aprox at 18:30 p.m.
- Dinner is optional and we recommend for the day "San Ángel Inn" Restaurant [www.sanangelinn.com](http://www.sanangelinn.com), a very special and one of the most famous and traditional restaurants in Mexico City. It is an old hacienda with Mexican and International Cuisine, this place is just a few meters from the

former Diego Rivera's workshop and studio. For men suit is needed for this restaurant. The pick up would be at the hour of your preference.

### **Friday**

- Mexican and International Breakfast at 7:00 a.m. in the Dining Room.
- Departure at 8:30 a.m. with the host guide towards Cuernavaca, a week end place for the people living in Mexico City. This place is 85 kms in distance from Mexico City.
- Another 80 kms of distance from Cuernavaca is a magical little silver town with the name of Taxco. This place has nice cobblestone and narrow alleys and a very picturesque architecture. The "Hotel Posada de la Mision" is waiting for you to have lunch (the meal is not included), with one of the nicest views of the town. At the tour in Taxco you will visit the Basilica de Santa Prisca a beautiful baroque church and also the Museo de la Plata (Silver Museum), you also will have a free time to shop.
- At Taxco or Cuernavaca (returning to Mexico City) the dinner would be held in a recommended restaurant.
- The arrival time at La Casita is aprox at 22:30 p.m.

### **Saturday**

- Mexican and International Breakfast at 8:00 a.m. in the Dining Room.
- Departure at 9:30 a.m. with the host guide to Coyoacan and its typical places such as: Plaza de Santa Catarina, Plaza Hidalgo, Jardín Centenario, Castle of Cortés, Parroquia de San Juan Bautista and Frida Kahlo Blue House Museum.
- After visiting the interesting sites around Coyoacán, you will be headed to a famous and spectacular bazaar at Plaza de San Jacinto (San Jacinto Square) that is only held on Saturdays, actually it's name is Bazaar del Sábado (Saturday Bazaar). You can have lunch over the nice restaurants around the square and also you can buy art crafts of the several boutiques and artists.
- And optional visit to Castillo de Chapultepec (Chapultepec's Castle) can be made after visiting San Jacinto Square.
- Dinner is optional and we recommend for the day "La Hacienda de los Morales" Restaurant [www.haciendadelosmorales.com](http://www.haciendadelosmorales.com), a very special and one of the most famous and traditional restaurants in Mexico City. It is an old hacienda with Mexican and International Cuisine, and has the most extended collection of tequilas in the world. For men suit is needed for this restaurant. The pick up would be at the hour of your preference. Another restaurant we can recommend is "Villa María" Restaurant

[www.villamaria.com.mx](http://www.villamaria.com.mx), a Mexican traditional Cuisine restaurant famous for its mariachi and trio's music singing inside the restaurant.
